The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. (However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for service.) If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reasons in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

The list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery fees, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Professional Service Charges

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff. \$2,180⁰⁰

Our professional service charge includes but is not limited to consultation with family and clergy, preparation and filing of necessary notices, authorizations and consents, attendance prior to, during and following the funeral and coordinating with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory and others.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charge for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming. \$650⁰⁰

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available.

Other Preparation of the Body. \$250⁰⁰

This consists of any cosmetics applied, hairdressing, dressing of the deceased and placing the deceased in the casket.

Use of Facilities for Funeral/Church or Chapel Set up/Graveside Service. \$595⁰⁰

Chapel for ceremony/rite/service.

Transfer of Remains to Funeral Home \$400⁰⁰

Initial removal from place of death or morgue facility.*

If additional staff is required, \$150⁰⁰ per person.

Hearse \$400⁰⁰

Delivery of deceased to cemetery or place of final disposition.*

Professional Service Charges

Casket Price Range from \$520⁰⁰ to \$3,624⁰⁰

A complete list will be provided at the funeral home.

Cremation Rental Casket \$995⁰⁰ to \$1,495⁰⁰

If you choose a funeral service where a rental casket is provided, the casket used for the funeral service may have been used in a previous funeral service. If the casket has been used in a previous funeral service, the interior lining has been replaced.

Alternative Cremation Container Price Range from \$95⁰⁰ to \$695⁰⁰

A complete list will be provided at the funeral home.

Outer Burial Container Price Range from \$920⁰⁰ to \$22,970⁰⁰

In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require that you buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so that the grave will not sink in. Either a grave liner or a burial vault will satisfy these requirements."

Urn Price Range from \$12⁰⁰ to \$1,448⁰⁰

Urn Vault Price Range from \$195⁰⁰ to \$495⁰⁰

Total Service Charge for Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home . . . \$1,595⁰⁰

This charge includes removal of remains, minimum service of staff, necessary authorizations, embalming and local transportation shipping container included (excluding shipping charges.) International shipping additional \$1500⁰⁰ or more. (Use of Funeral Home for visitation is available at an additional expense. There is also an additional expense for professional services.)*

Total Service Charge for Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home . . . \$1,595⁰⁰

This charge includes minimum services of staff, transportation from airport, transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory. (Use of Funeral Home for visitation or service is available at an additional expense. There is also an additional expense for professional services.)*

Total Service Charge for Immediate Burials \$1,595⁰⁰

Simple graveside service with one attendant present at graveside, removal from place of death, preparation and filing of all necessary notices, authorizations and consents. Placing of the deceased in casket, hearse transportation to cemetery. Price does not include casket, vault, embalming or cemetery expenses.*

Immediate burial with casket or alternative container provided by consumer \$1,595⁰⁰

Immediate burial with minimum cloth covered casket provided by funeral home \$2,115⁰⁰

Immediate burial with casket purchased from funeral home (in addition to cost of casket selected) \$1,595⁰⁰

**Total Service Charge for Direct Cremation (For Cremation Society Members) \$1,795⁰⁰
(For Non-Members) \$1,845⁰⁰**

Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are (specify containers provided). Cremation Authorization Fee by Medical Examiner or Coroner. (not included)*

Direct cremation with alternative container purchased from funeral home \$1,940⁰⁰

Additional Goods and Services Available

CHAPEL RENTAL: \$595⁰⁰. Includes an attendant at the service. Our chapels can accommodate seating for 125 people.

RECEPTION ROOM: \$295⁰⁰ with the use of our chapel or \$595⁰⁰ if you choose to use the reception room only.

We provide: • paper plates, cups, napkins, disposable forks and spoons • coffee • clean up

Staff Coordinator at Memorial Service at another facility, church OR graveside: \$225^{00*}.

(The staff coordinator is a non-licensed director; for the licensed director add \$150⁰⁰ to all of the above charges.)

Register Books: \$25⁰⁰ - \$125⁰⁰.

Memorial Folders: Printed with our verse or prayer.

\$55⁰⁰ for 50; \$20⁰⁰ for each additional 50 + sales tax.

2nd side printing add \$20⁰⁰ or printing of your verse or prayer add \$20⁰⁰.

Photo Folders: \$1⁰⁰ each (minimum 75)

Prayer Cards: \$40⁰⁰ for 50; \$25⁰⁰ for each additional 50 + sales tax (standard format only)

Thank You Cards: \$15⁰⁰ per box of 25 + sales tax.

Delivery of cremated remains or service material: \$50^{00*}.

Flowers: Simple arrangements from \$100⁰⁰.

Private Family Viewing: \$150⁰⁰. (Limited to immediate family by Minnesota statute 149.A) (Limit of 30 minutes)

Private Family Viewing or witnessing containers available for purchase.

Witnessing of Cremation: \$250⁰⁰. (Limited to immediate family by Minnesota statute 149.A)

Mailing or shipping of Cremated Remains: Express mail: \$95⁰⁰.

Storage of Cremated Remains: \$15⁰⁰ per month after 60 days.

Additional transportation of remains \$400⁰⁰ each way.*

Use of our facilities for procedures performed by outside staff: \$500⁰⁰.

Sheltering of human remains after 6 days: \$50⁰⁰ per day.

DNA Services \$295 - \$895.

Other Charges You May Incur Which Are Outside Charges

Clergy Honorarium Suggested: \$250⁰⁰.

Organist/Soloist Suggested: \$200⁰⁰ each.

Certified Copies of the Death Certificate - Minnesota: \$13⁰⁰ for the first copy and \$6⁰⁰ for each additional copy.

Wisconsin: \$20⁰⁰ for the first copy and \$3⁰⁰ for each additional copy.

Obituary: All newspapers require a credit card prior to placing an obituary.

Cemetery: Our funeral directors will assist the family with making any burial arrangements. The cemetery will accept your check or credit card for payment.

Motorcycle Escort: \$230⁰⁰ per driver + sales tax.

Medical Examiner or Coroner Fee for cremation varies by county, up to \$250⁰⁰ for Cremation Authorization.
